Pilgrims Way, Wouldham

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2021

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Pilgrims Way, Wouldham.

A closure is planned from 24th May 2021, with estimated completion by 28th June 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50030582424 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the woks will be displayed on One.Network


Pilgrims Way will be closed from outside number 322 to the junction with Knowle Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.


The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while electrical connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for traffic travelling northbound is via Rochester Road, Pilgrims Way, Rochester Road, Chatham Road, A229 Blue Bell Hill, B2097 Maidstone Road, Priestfields, Borstal Street, Wouldham Road, Burham Road and Pilgrims Way.

The alternative route for traffic travelling southbound is via Wouldham Road, Borstal Street, Priestfields, B2097 Maidstone Road, A229 Blue Bell Hill, Kits Coty Slip Southbound Off, Rochester Road, Pilgrims Way, Rochester Road and Pilgrims Way.
